### **Directions to the Boat Show:**

**FROM LYNCHBURG & BEDFORD, VA.** Take 460 West to Bedford. Take Route 122 South. Turn left on route 608 (White House Road). Follow 608 until it intersects with route 626 (about 5-6 miles) at Smith Mtn. Lake Parkway. Turn right onto 626. Follow 626 for .8 of a mile and turn left into Mariners Landing.

**FROM ROANOKE, VA.** From 581 south, take the exit for route 24 (Elm Avenue). At top of ramp turn left and follow 24 through Vinton, and continue on 24 for about 15 miles. At the traffic light make a right onto Route 122 South. Follow Bedford directions.

**FROM MARTINSVILLE, VA.** Take 220 North to Rocky Mount, and then follow signs for route 122 north. Follow 122 to route and make a right turn on 608 in Moneta (a few miles after crossing the bridge at the lake). Follow route 608. Refer to Bedford Directions from 608.
